SUPPORTING EVIDENCE

The data utilized in the SDM Tool are derived from scientific sources adhering to a hierarchical structure outlined below:

- The first source of information is the Prescribing Information obtained from regulatory bodies such as the EMA (European Medicines Agency) and FDA (Food and Drug Administration) pertaining to a specific product.
- In cases where a product is exclusively available in countries outside the FDA and EMA jurisdiction, data from other relevant regulatory bodies was considered.
- Published results from the pivotal Phase 3 clinical trials, documented in scientific journals, serve as secondary sources of information if needed.

No other studies were taken into account as supporting documentation for quantitative data within the SDM Tool.
